Moving Packing List

Simplify your move with this step-by-step moving packing list

Before You Pack

- Donate or toss items you do not want to move
- Set aside important documents and valuables
- Take photos of electronic setups before unplugging
- Keep tape, markers, and labels in one tote
- Use small boxes for heavy items and big boxes for light items

Living Room

- Pack books, decor, and media in smaller boxes
- Wrap lamps, vases, and breakables carefully
- Use moving blankets for mirrors and furniture
- Keep remotes and small hardware in labeled bags
- Bundle cords together with stretch wrap or ties

Kitchen

- Pack rarely used kitchen items first
- Use packing paper for dishes and glassware
- Wrap fragile pieces with bubble wrap or dish towels
- Label appliance parts and cords in plastic bags
- Donate unopened food you will not use
- Clearly mark fragile boxes

Dining Room

- Pack serving dishes and extra glassware early
- Use padding between plates and bowls
- Wrap centerpieces, candles, and decor securely
- Label boxes clearly so breakables are easy to spot
- Keep one easy meal setup out until the end

Bedroom

- Use moving bags for clothes, linens, and pillows
- Use suitcases for shoes and heavier clothes
- Add mattress bags before moving day
- Keep a few outfits and pajamas out until the end
- Set aside jewelry and valuables
- Start a donation bag for clothes you no longer want

Bathroom

- Place anything that could leak in a sealed plastic bag
- Keep medications with you, not on the truck
- Leave out daily toiletries until the end
- Pack towels and extra supplies in small boxes or bags
- Use cleaning wipes and paper towels for last-minute cleanup



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Home Office

- Use a file box or folder for important papers
- Label chargers, cables, and computer accessories
- Take a photo of desk and cord setup before disconnecting
- Keep work essentials accessible if you still need them
- Pack office supplies in small, labeled boxes

Garage + Outdoor

- Set aside tools you will need on moving day
- Bundle awkward items with stretch wrap
- Safely wrap sharp tools and fragile gear
- Pack seasonal and storage items first
- Keep extension cords, tape, and utility tools easy to reach

Kids' Rooms

- Keep favorite comfort items easy to find
- Pack books, toys, and keepsakes in labeled boxes
- Leave out pajamas and a few outfits
- Set aside school supplies and chargers
- Keep a small activity bag handy for moving day

Moving Day Essentials

- Phone charger and backup battery
- Snacks and water
- Tape, markers, and labels
- Paper towels, toilet paper, and hand soap
- Trash bags and cleaning wipes
- Important documents and first aid kit
- Box cutter and basic tools

Laundry + Closets

- Use moving bags for towels, blankets, and extra bedding
- Pack seasonal clothes and storage items first
- Keep laundry soap and a few hangers accessible
- Use vacuum bags if you need to save space
- Start a donation pile while you pack

First-Night Box

- Toilet paper and paper towels
- Hand soap and cleaning wipes
- Trash bags and shower curtain liner
- Towels, pajamas, and a change of clothes
- Medications and chargers
- Paper plates, utensils, snacks, and water bottles
- Basic tool kit and box cutter
- Pet food, bowls, and kids' bedtime items
